

Fourth Ohio Volunteer Cavalry

This Regiment was organized at Camp Dennison and Camp Gurley, Ohio, in November 1861, with the exception of Co's L and M, which were organized August 15, 1862, at Cincinnati, Ohio, to serve three years. The original members (except veterans) were mustered out by detachments in October, 1864, by reason of expiration of term of service, and the organization, composed of veterans and recruits, retained in service until July 15, 1865, when it was mustered out in accordance with orders from the War Department.

The official list of battles, in which this Regiment bore an honorable part, is not yet published by the War Department, but the following list has been compiled, after careful research, during the preparation of this work:
