

## Military Records

Enrolled or mustered in December 25, 1861 at Clifton for 3 years. Company descriptive book: age 34; height 5 feet 10  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches; dark complexion; blue eyes; dark hair. Born Rockbridge, Virginia. Occupation farmer. Enlisted December 25, 1861, at Clifton by C.S. Woley. Deserted from Camp Chase, April 17, 1862.

On August 6, 1886, the charge of desertion of April 17, 1862, against Edward W. Hayslett was removed under the provisions of the act of Congress, approved July 5, 1884, (Adjutant General's Office, War Department, Book mark: 4044-6-1882). He was absent without proper authority from April 17<sup>th</sup>, 1862, to June 11, 1862, when he was admitted to Post Hospital Camp chase, Ohio, diagnosis not stated, and discharged on Surgeon's certificate of disability at Columbus, Ohio, June 16, 1862.
