

## **In Memory HARRISON STURGES**

Harrison STURGES was born at Kankakee, Illinois, Feb. 2, 1884, to Robert and Barbara STURGES. He was united in marriage to Esther ANDERSON. To this union three daughters were born: Bernice, Myra and Dorothy. Harrison was united in marriage to Laura HALLMER. To this union five daughters and two sons were born: Mary Ann, Virginia, Susan, Sally, Mildred, Thomas and William.
